The "R" in the DIR® model: Relationship-based Published online October 9, 2015

Summary: The <u>Relationship</u> in DIR/Floortime® refers to the genuine use of affect in our interactions, considering the child's individual differences, and the child's developmental level

- Relationship is the <u>most</u> important part of the DIR/Floortime® intervention
- Children develop and learn through their emotional experiences within safe, loving, and nurturing relationships
- According to Dr. Gordon Neufeld, our brains are wired to not look to anyone with whom we do not have a relationship to guide us
- "Relationships enable progress in the child's overall functional and emotional development" (from the DIR® Fact Sheet)
