KultureCity: Sensory Accessibility and Inclusion

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Summary: KultureCity is a non-profit organization that certifies public places as accessible and Sensory Inclusive™ by providing sensory areas and training staff how to recognize sensory sensitivities of individuals with invisible disabilities including autism and PTSD

- Taking *awareness* to the next steps of acceptance and then inclusion is really what is so important about what KultureCity does
- KultureCity makes it possible for sensory sensitive people to attend public venues and events such as music festivals
- With KultureCity training, the onus is not placed on the individual with the invisible disability, but on society to include everyone
- KultureCity also has Sensory Activation VEHicles (S.A.V.E.) that act as mobile sensory rooms at outdoor events and portable sensory kits for students at home doing online schooling
- KultureBall and KCFit are fundraising events held throughout each year involving high-profile names like the band *Imagine Dragons*
